Christian Malford C of E Primary School Behaviour Principles

High standards of behaviour are the key to the success of the school so that all pupils make the best possible progress in all areas of school life. This also enables staff to maintain high standards of learning for all.

This document sets out the behaviour principles at Christian Malford C of E Primary School and has been drawn up by the Local Board in consultation with the staff, parents and pupils. These principles should be read in conjunction with the school's behaviour policy which can be found on the school website.

We believe that high standards of behaviour at Christian Malford C of E Primary School will promote a safe, healthy and happy environment for pupils. The school will aim to develop the following attitudes in its pupils:

- respect for oneself and for all others
- high self-esteem and self confidence
- high expectations and a desire to achieve
- self-motivation
- co-operation
- independence
- self-discipline.

All members of the school community will promote high standards of behaviour. An appropriate commonsense approach should be applied to the following principles:

- all members of the school community will be treated with respect
- everyone will consider the needs and well-being of others.
- behaviour will be dealt with consistently and fairly, using a positive approach
- everyone will be valued as individuals and given equal opportunities
- good behaviour will be recognised, rewarded and celebrated
- everyone will be expected to follow the school rules.
